Fees:

Please make checks payable to the Fremont County Fair.
Non – members must pay a \$20.00 office fee per season or \$10.00 per show.
Junior/Young Rider - \$7.00
Senior Rider - \$10.00

***To be eligible for year-end high point awards, Non-members of the Tri State Dressage must pay a \$20.00 office fee per season or \$10.00 per show to Tri State Dressage. Please send separate checks.

Schedule:

Friday, July 24th

Open Show unofficial ride times are scheduled and e-mailed to exhibitors 2 days before show
Official ride times will be posted by 9:00am at the Dressage arena.

Show will begin at 9:00am

Jr. 4-H and FFA rides will begin at 1:00pm if halter classes allow. Please check in at dressage arena for official schedule by 12:30pm.

Programmed Ride, intro and training level – in the 20 m x 40 m arena, unless otherwise indicated
All other test – in the 20 m X 60 M arena

JR/YR – Riders (20 yrs & under – Jan 1 of the current year)

Rules

1. USEF and 4-H/FFA rules apply. Informal dress is acceptable. English tack and attire is normally used at Dressage Shows. We will allow the JR/YR division to use the 4-H/FFA rules for Programmed ride Test 1 & 2, Intro Level Test A & B and Training Level Test 1 & 2. Refer to the Wyoming State 4-H/FFA Rule book, under Programmed Ride. English riders ASTM/SEI certified helmets and heeled boots are required. Western riders ASTM/SEI certified helmets are recommended and heeled boots required. Helmets are available at the show.
2. Tests may be called.
3. Show management may cancel, change, combine, and split classes or change jump heights if circumstances require it.
4. Entry form must be completed entirely and full payment of fees must accompany form. All signatures are required.
5. **Entries Close:** Entries are due in the Fremont County Fair Office by 5:00 pm, Wednesday, July 20, 2005. No entries will accepted over the phone. Post entries will only be accepted if space and time permits. Post entry is an additional \$5.00 per class.
6. Substitution of rider, horse, or ride time will be made only at the discretion of show management and will require a fee of \$10.00.
7. **Stabling:** On grounds, 8 x 8 covered box stalls are \$10.00 per night. Large bags of shavings available on grounds for \$6.00 per bag. If you need a stall during the horse show, please complete a stabling form on the reverse side of the entry form. Exhibitors who must travel a long distance will be given a priority to stall horses on the grounds during the show. Stall assignments will be made by show management. Current Fremont County 4-H/FFA members are exempt from stall fees. **Horses stabled on the grounds must be accompanied by a copy of Neg. Coggins Test taken within 12 months. Stallions must be stalled off grounds. Reminder: No stallions shall be exhibited by 4-H/FFA members.**
8. No stallions may enter the show or be on the grounds.
9. ASTM/SEI certified helmets and proper attire is required for English riders. For Western riders ASTM/SEI certified helmets are recommended, proper attire is required.
10. **Lameness:** In the case of marked lameness, the judge informs the exhibitor that he/she is eliminated. There is no appeal against the judge's decision.
11. **Scratches:** Refunds will be made only upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian or medical doctor attesting to illness or injury. Statement must be received prior to the day of the show. NO EXCEPTIONS.
12. **Ride Times:** will be posted at the Dressage Arena. Please be at the dressage arena at least 10 minutes prior to your scheduled ride time. Failure to enter the arena within 90 seconds after the judge rings the bell signaling the rider to enter the arena results in a disqualification. No exhibitor can be required to ride before his/her scheduled ride time. If circumstances permit, it is a courtesy to the show and judge to accede to a request to ride earlier than their scheduled time.
13. To receive your personal list of ride times, please include your e-mail address on your entry form. Ride times will be posted at dressage arena by 9 am show day.
14. Tack will be checked before entry into the arena at the discretion of the show management.
15. Exhibitor may never warm up nor ride in the official dressage arena, except when called by the judge to ride his/her test.
16. Exhibitor may warm up and around the outside of the dressage arena while the judge is scoring the previous test ridden. (No cantering when a test is being ridden.)
17. Class results will be posted when class is completely scored and placed. Tests will not be released nor shown until a class is posted. No test will be released to anyone but the rider or rider's representative. Riders are encouraged to check their tests for errors.
18. Show management reserves the right to refuse the entry of any exhibitor for cause; to have any horse removed from the grounds for cause; to return any entry fee and eliminate the exhibitor for cause; all being without any liability or compensation.
19. **Arenas:** 20 m X 40 m (or) 20 m X 60 m Dressage arena in the green arena, warm up around the outside of show arena. Dirt footing. (No cantering when a test is being ridden.)
20. **Veterinarian and Farrier on call:** Posted at the Fair Grounds.
21. Concessions: At Fair Grounds.
22. **Accommodations and Directors:** Available at the Fremont County Fair web site, www.fremontcountyfair.org
23. There will be visual check of all horses entering the fair grounds. You must have the special health inspection from county veterinarians. Any questions, call fair office or superintendent.
